



TRAINING PROPOSAL

Process for Submission to Camo2Commerce

Requirements

- Training for certification is 12 weeks or less
- Training uses a cohort model for ideally 8-10 participants per cohort
- Placement Testing – what is your process and what does it include?
Examples: National Certification, Prior Learning Assessment, Accuplacer, CASAS

Training is in one of the following sectors:

- Management/Operations Healthcare
 - Financial Services
 - Childcare/Early Childhood Education
 - Hospitality/Tourism
 - Paralegal
 - Paraeducator
 - Apprenticeship/Preapprenticeship
- ◆ Jobs pay \$12-20/hr minimum
 - ◆ Provide timeline for curriculum development, instructor hiring, outreach, program launch, and duration
 - ◆ C2C funding does NOT include new curriculum development
 - ◆ Demonstrate multiple delivery options, timelines, and instructional formats
 - Ex: Accelerated courses, online, in-person, Evening/Weekend classes, condensed training schedules, etc.
 - ◆ Provide budget estimate for program delivery:
 - One to three programs will be selected
 - Total of 20 participants across all selected proposals with maximum cost per participant \$3,750
 - ◆ Complete proposals will be no more than five pages in length and must include contact information for organization, program contact, timeline as stated above, budget, any partner organizations, how the organization is qualified to deliver the program, and narrative overview of program design including delivery model
 - ◆ Review criteria includes quality of program design, cost reasonableness, and organization's capability to provide program
- Preferred:**
- ◆ Program includes or has ability to align with entrepreneur or small business training
 - ◆ Childcare options included during active class time if in-person

Process

- ◆ Email proposal to Camo2Commerce at: lori@pacmtn.org
- ◆ Confirmation of receipt of proposal will occur within two (2) business days
- ◆ Proposal will be initially reviewed for completeness within five (5) business days
- ◆ Communication will occur whether selected or not
- ◆ **Proposals will be reviewed on a rolling basis beginning 3/28/18 through 4/30/18 or until all funding has been allocated, whichever occurs first**

Short-Term Industry Certifications for Military Spouses

Challenge

Finding short-term (12 weeks or less) certificate programs that military spouses can access to get back to work quickly upon PCS or transition.

Historically

Military spouses may have certifications that do not transfer interstate, making getting back into the workforce at a new duty station with minimal impact challenging. Providing short-term certification programs to military spouses enables this group to get back to work quickly and continue supporting their families with minimal disruption.

Requirements

For all short-term training programs, the potential to align with JBLM training requirements mandates the gathering of the information to the left.

Maximum cost per participant of \$3,750

Placements

Our goal is a minimum of 84% placements from these programs and the partnership and commitment with companies who hire students completing the training.
