## **JBLM Spouse Ambassadors**

This internship position\* opportunity for Spouse Ambassadors will play a vital role in recruiting and mentoring military spouses in our Year of the Spouse initiative. Ambassadors will engage with military spouses to participate/enroll in short-term educational training programs (12 weeks or less) that will culminate in an earned certificate upon completion. Additionally, Spouse Ambassadors will support and connect the military with the public work force sector in WA.

### ***As a Spouse Ambassador you will:***

- attend initial training week (32 hours)
- have a flexible schedule, routinely working between 8-25 hours per week;
- be part of an exciting, dynamic team for 3-6 months;
- provide valuable information and connection to services;
- attend weekly team meetings and on-going training as merited
- and complete a pre-approved volunteer project on a monthly basis

### ***What you need for the Spouse Ambassador program:***

- outgoing and friendly attitude, willing to engage with military spouses and families;
- passion and excitement while providing information about the program to the public;
- good time management and organizational abilities;
- creativity, initiative and desire to help others; and
- excellent communication and teamwork skills

We are looking for 10 Ambassadors to be available between May 15 and November 15, 2018. Ambassadors will be paid \$12 per hour. Some travel may be required. \*To qualify for this internship program you must meet Camo2Commerce program eligibility requirements.
