### Youth Survey Report 2018 A message from our youth~




In total, 66 surveys were completed and returned to PacMtn WDC; the content provided in this presentation was derived entirely from the information gathered from those 66 surveys.

#### 80% of participants were between ages 16 and 20 years old.



- Transportation



## What makes you the most hopeful?




- I love living in a progressive society and believe by faith, social justice is becoming a viable career




## Do you need a college education to be successful?






#### Education is beyond my financial means.






## There are not enough apprenticeships or internships near me






## There are not enough jobs I would want in the area where I want to live or work






#### My dream is to own my own business.






## I know someone that can talk about what a good worker I am.






#### Transportation or getting place-to-place is a challenge for me.






# What message do you want to send to any of your future employers?
