WIOA Youth: Low Income Guidelines

(70% of Lower Living Standard Income Level)

Family of 1 uses Poverty Guidelines (shown below) as it is a higher standard than 70% of LLSIL for this category

Examples of other low income criteria:

- DSHS Cash Payments (includes TANF, GAU,SSI)
- Food Stamps (within the last six months)
- Homeless
- Foster Child
- Disabled (counts as family of one for low income)
