Pacific Mountain Workforce Development Council seeks letters of interest for regional business solutions capacity building services

Olympia, February 16, 2024 - The Pacific Mountain Workforce Development Council (PacMtn) is initiating a Request for Information (RFI) to invite Letters of Interest from eligible organizations for the provision of Regional Business Solutions Capacity Building services.

PacMtn invites eligible organizations to submit letters of interest for the funding of a minimum of two business association consortiums for a 15-month period spanning from April 1, 2024, to June 30, 2025.

A total funding pool of \$950,000 is available to support the following objectives:

1. Increase local Business Solution Navigator capacity
2. Coordinate local and support regional career exploration events
3. Strengthen local business association capabilities to support non-English-speaking business owners
4. Measure economic impact resulting from regional EcSA investments
