## **Pacific Mountain Workforce Development Council Issues Requests for Proposals for Young Adult Services and Capacity Building**

Olympia, July 10, 2024 - Pacific Mountain Workforce Development Council (PacMtn) is initiating two Requests for Proposals (RFPs) targeting young adult services under the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) and capacity building for organizations serving marginalized communities.

### **WIOA Young Adult Services:**

PacMtn seeks qualified service providers to deliver comprehensive services to achieve WIOA Youth Outcomes in Grays Harbor, Lewis, Mason, Pacific, and Thurston counties. The focus will be on education, training, and employment support for youth facing systemic barriers.

Proposals are welcomed from consortiums of organizations, including local small, minority-, or women-owned organizations, and those with innovative program models. Proposals must outline program designs covering outreach, eligibility determination, individual service strategies, case management, and follow-up services.

PacMtn is seeking proposals from "By and For" organizations to support capacity building and provide financial coaching services aimed at poverty reduction.
