Pacific Mountain Workforce Development Council Issues RFP for America's Job Center Network - One-Stop Operator

Olympia, WA – Pacific Mountain Workforce Development Council (PacMtn) has released a Request for Proposals (RFP) seeking qualified organizations to serve as the One-Stop Operator (OSO) for its America's Job Center (AJC) Network. The selected OSO will lead efforts to deliver seamless, innovative, and equitable workforce services across PacMtn's five-county region, meeting the needs of both job seekers and employers.

Key Responsibilities of the One-Stop Operator:

- **Unifying the Region:** Coordinate services across multiple AJC locations to ensure consistency and accessibility.
- **Advancing Value-Driven Goals:** Align operations with PacMtn's mission to support a dynamic workforce landscape.
- **Innovating Service Delivery:** Leverage new strategies for in-person, online, and remote services.
- **Enhancing Data-Driven Performance:** Use analytics to monitor and improve service effectiveness.
- **Fostering Collaboration:** Cultivate partnerships to maximize resources and enhance customer satisfaction.

The OSO will play a critical role in operationalizing a unified, job-driven service delivery system, ensuring services are customer-centered and aligned with PacMtn's regional economy.

Eligibility and Requirements:

The RFP is open to organizations identified as eligible under 20 CFR 678.600. These include public, private, nonprofit entities, workforce intermediaries, chambers of commerce, and more. Proposals must demonstrate the capability to fulfill OSO responsibilities effectively.


