Pacific Mountain Workforce Development Council Issues RFP for WIOA Young Adult Services

Olympia, WA – The Pacific Mountain Workforce Development Council (PacMtn) has released a Request for Proposals (RFP) seeking qualified subrecipient(s) to provide Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) Title I Young Adult Services. This initiative aims to serve Out-of-School Youth & Young Adults (OSY) aged 16–24 years, equipping them with the skills, education, and support necessary to overcome barriers, pursue meaningful career pathways, and achieve long-term economic self-sufficiency.

- **Support Youth Development:** Focus on engaging youth in innovative workforce development programs that promote long-term economic self-sufficiency.
- **Align with WIOA Goals:** Deliver services that meet federal performance outcomes and align with PacMtn's mission to support a dynamic workforce landscape.
- **Foster Collaboration:** Build partnerships with local organizations and experts to maximize resources and impact.

Programs may vary in scope and funding amounts but must demonstrate alignment with the overarching goals of WIOA and PacMtn's regional priorities.
